8. <u>Significance</u>: This is a very good, intact example of the simplest form of the local Wood Vernacular house. The twenty-five foot wide lot dictated the single-file shape. The limited decoration is concentrated on the porch; the height of which is so low that the stick frieze was omitted across the front.

Long a residence, this building was recently converted for use by Dr. Douglas Hughs who has used a dark color to accent the porch details, watertable end boards, and frieze boards.
