DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

- The Conklin-Montgomery House is a 2 story brick 1. Exterior. 10 x 12 void regular hip and end gable roofed town house. Its principal elevation is the north elevation facing the National Road. The main entry on the north elevation is a 2 story distyle in antis recessed frontispiece of superimposed orders with a balcony at the second floor level. The lower order is Greek There are secondary entries on Ionic, the upper Greek Doric. the east and west elevations. The norther entry on the west elevation leads to a large parlour which was probably Conklin's counting house. The east elevation entry has a Gothic style wooden cut-out type a porch surrounding it. The south elevation a two story recessed entryway supported by superimposed orders, which was originally open to the ground level as a carriageway for goods hauled to Conklin's commission and forwar-The roof line is quite unusual. The east elevation is a gable end. The west elevation is hipped. The main cornice is basically Greek Ionic. All sash are 6 x 6 lights and appear to be original to the house. The exterior doors, except for the single panel north door, are common 4 panel doors. The kitchen is located in a l story attached brick gabled ell on the south elevation, topped by a bell tower.
- The first floor plan consists of two parlours 2. Interior. flanking the entrance hall from the north entry. Behind the two parlours on each side of the house are located two more rooms, whose use pattern is unclear. These rooms and a second set of two rooms are separated_by the carriageway, which is now floored over at the first floor level. Exterior 4 panel doors with overdoor lights give access to the carriageway from each set of rooms. The second floor plan consists of six similar chambers and a large loft type room over the carriageway. The northwest parlour is traditionally referred to as the "counting house". It has no working fireplace, the mantel in the room being a dummy mantel. The fireplace trim throughout the house is of Grecian design, showing some traces of LeFever's books. The best mantel in the house is in the northeast parlour. It is a semi-freestanding columnar mantel with an interesting center ornament on the mantel freize. The standing trim consists of a reeded architrave with corner blocks containing inscribed circles after Asher Benjamin's style. All interior doors are 4 panel doors. The main stairway which rises directly inside the north entry is circular. It has an excellent newel post and fine balusters. 3. Accessory Buildings. A l story latticework gazebo of pre Civil War vintage is situated in the east garden, which is laid out in 18th century parterre style. Other early outbuildings have disappeared.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

- 1. Architectural Significance. The Conklin-Montgomery House is the best-preserved combination counting house and home in the Midwest. It is an unique piece of architecture for Indiana. In this structure banking, merchantile and residential requirements have been functionally related to make an articulated and sophisticated major work. The choice of detailing, organization of voids and solids, and the unusual carriageway and roof treatment indicates that the structure was intended to have a dual function from its inception. The Conklin-Montgomery House shows the New York origin of its owner in its details and trim. It is one of a kind in Indiana. It was the home and business house of a wealthy merchant and money lender, built just prior to 1840. It is unrelated to any other Wayne County structure in style and design. It is a fine example of a peculiar form of architecture.
- 2. <u>Historical Significance</u>. Conklin-Montgomery House was built as a residence and counting house by Benjamin Conklin ca. 1836-1838. Conklin was a storekeeper in nearby Vandalia who relocated to the National Road and specialized in money lending and in commission and forwarding on the Whitewater Canal. He was considered wealthy for the time. He maintained his business offices in the house until his death in the early 1860's. The house was sold out of the family in 1864. It was later repurchased by Harriet Conklin, Benjamin's daughter in 1889. It was acquired by its present owner in 1944, in poor repair. The Montgomery family has restored the house to much of its original appearance since that time.

Benjamin Conklin was a major personality in his community. He was one of the original proprietors of the Town of Cambridge (now Cambridge City). He was politically and commercially active in Indiana government and business until his death.
