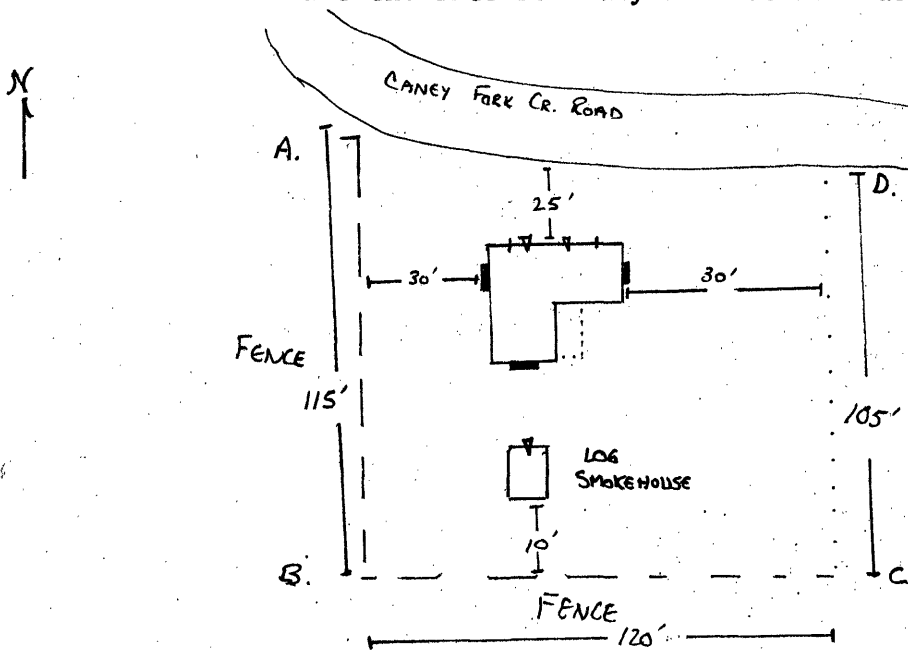

Verbal Boundary Description

Acreage .3 ACRES

Beginning at point A on a fence line S of Caney Fork Creek Road and approximately 40' NW of the NW corner of the house; thence S along said fence line approximately 115' to point B, the intersection of a fence line forming the southern boundary; thence E along said fence line approximately 120' to point C, an intersection with an imaginary line which runs 30' each of the eastern edge of the house and forms the eastern boundary; thence N along said imaginary line approximately 105' to point D on the southern edge of the Casey Fork Creek Road, said point approximately 35' NE of the NE corner of the house; thence along the southern right-of-way of the Casey Fork Creek Road as it meanders to the beginning.
