



#### Physical Description

This stately Colonial Revival house projects qualities of formality and dignity in the older residential section of the small town of Lonoke, Arkansas. The large two-story structure, faced with narrow weatherboards, and capped by a gable roof is situated on a large corner lot shaded by large water oak trees. Highlighting the facade is a large flat-roofed portico featuring a full but unembellished entablature which is supported by four monumental Tuscan columns and enriched with an upper balustrade of urn-shaped balusters. Centered in the roof above this portico is a large gable roof dormer, with simple brackets and exposed rafters, which contains three multi-pane sash windows. framed by a wide architrave composed of simple moldings and features a paneled front door with a long, semi-elliptical fanlight and multi-pane sidelights. narrow sash windows with multi-panes appear on the second floor above the entry. The portico is placed somewhat off-center on the facade and the south end of the front elevation originally had semi-enclosed porches on both the first and second floors. The wide sash windows have nine-over-one lights, An unusually handsome feature of this house is the long pergola walkway and the stylish detached garage to the south which is connected to the house by means of the walkway. Tuscan columns on high brick plinths support the pergola and the overhanging pedimented gable roof of the garage as well.

#### Statement of Significance

The Walls House in Lonoke is a Colonial Revival styled home designed by Charles L. Thompson in 1913. Dramatic in its small town setting, the Walls House is a large two-story structure set on a corner lot in Lonoke's residential section. Again, Thompson combined some Craftsman details with Colonial Revival styling. Wide overhanging eaves with exposed rafters and wide sash windows bespeak Craftsman influence. Marking the facade is a large flat-roofed portico supported by four monumental Tuscan columns. The portico is topped by a balustrade of urn-shaped balusters. A distinctive feature of the Walls House is a long pergola walkway and detached garage to the south of the house. The pergola with its overhanging pedimented gable roof is supported by Tuscan columns. The entrance portico, pergola and detached garage add a formal and unique note to the Walls House.
