
2. Location: approximately 50' southeast of highway 61 and 1/2 mile north of Grant/Luna County line

4. <u>Owner</u>: Albert Aguilera, Route 15, Box 1300, Faywood, New Mexico

7. <u>Description</u>: Photos 69, 70; rear-facing U-shape plan; concrete foundation skirt; stuccoed adobe; corrugated metal hipped and gable roofs, hipped porch roof; 4/4 double hung windows; single door in w/d/w porch symmetry. A bunkhouse/garage, photo 70 left, although similar in appearance, was constructed in 1958 and is not included in this nomination.

8. <u>Significance</u>: This house was built in 1928 by Ramon Baca who is the brother of Ed Baca who remodeled the Soliz-Baca, # 30, to the north. They are descendents of another Ramon Baca who was one of the first homesteaders of the area and the developer of an east side irrigation ditch. The house meets Criterion C as a well preserved example of the New Mexico Vernacular type. The use of adobe and the single room deep, rear-facing U-shaped plan shown the general conservatism of the tradition; while the isolated window/door/window symmetry of the entrance responds to Anglo-American traditions.

10. <u>Geographical Data</u>: Approximate Acreage: less than one. Quadrangle Name: Dwyer, N.M. Scale: 1: 62,500 UTM References: 13 229350 3611600 Verbal boundary: A rectangle, roughly 65' by 50', formed by lines parallel to and ten feet from the exterior walls of the house. Since this is an unplatted area, this boundary has been created to include only the house.




17. Ramon Baca House (29) Historic Resources of the Mimbres Valley, 1987
