

#### Physical Description

This large two-story house, faced with wide weatherboards, is located on a spacious corner lot surrounded by beautiful landscaping, green lawns and large spreading trees. Adding both unity and a picturesque aura is the huge front gable with pent roof which dominates the composition. Projecting to either side are gable end sections. Adding complexity and asymmetry to the roofscape is a somewhat lower cross gable projection on the front. The steep slant of these two intersecting gables lends a picturesque effect augmented by a third gable roof projection over the entrance. To the north a small porch lined with lattice work connects the house with an attached garage. A porch on the south end of the front elevation, now enclosed, is supported by oversized and simplified Tuscan-like stucco columns two of which support the triangular pediment of the small front porch as well. Large brackets line the eaves; wood shingles enrich the cross gable overhang on the south elevation. A variety of window sizes augments the informality of the whole. Most windows are sash with six-over-one lights.

#### Statement of Significance

Across the side street from the Wheat House (LN-064) in Lonoke, the Trimble House rests on a corner lot in a lush tree-shaded residential section of the town. This 1916 Charles L. Thompson design is unusual in relation to the firm's other work. Although the two-story frame house is large, the asymmetry and complexity of lines and the roofscape create a kind of cottage-like informality and charm. Two oversized columns support the now enclosed porch on the south end of the front elevation. The house features a variety of window styles, adding to the informality. Of particular interest is the original attached garage on the north end of the house.




