One-and-a-half-story gable-roof L-plan frame residence with undercut gallery, five bays by two. Ell on southwest facade has shed-roof porch and original mantelpieces in every room. trim and pilasters which repeat the pedimenthead vertical panel seen on double-leaf doors, side lights, and transom framed by shouldered architrave the columns. that aligns with center hall of front section. Entrance frontispiece with Jib doors along front gallery; five chimneys with fireplace
