

A detailed description of the physical characteristics of the stone is given in the Boundary Markers of the Original District of Columbia Multiple Documentation Form.

Intermediate boundary marker Southeast #6 is situated in the landscaped front lawn of the Trible's Inc. Company located at 901 Southern Avenue. It is located approximately 40 feet southeast of the centerline of Southern Avenue and 305 feet southwest of Wheeler Avenue. The sandstone marker is in excellent condition. A 3' x 3' x 5' iron fence, in good condition, surrounds the marker.
