


#### Physical Description

This two-story brick building with flat roof is quite long, its facade being organized into a slightly projecting central section, marked by a heightened parapet, and two projecting end bays. The use of banks of multi-paned sash windows, red brick trimmed generously with light-colored cast stone (most noticeably in quoins and Gibbs surrounds) and classical details creates a traditional and small-scale effect which counteracts the large size of the building and its modern, simple massing. Decorating the recessed central doorway are fluted stone pilasters which support a full entablature with the name "Caldwell Hall" inscribed on the frieze and surmounted by stone plinths framing a balustrade of urn-shaped balusters. The parapet over the entrance features three stone panels carved with Art Deco-inspired motifs inscribed with the original name of the college: "Agriculture," "Mechanical," and "Normal." Two fluted stone piers with pointed finials separate these panels, extending well above and below them to create somewhat streamlined points of accent.

### Statement of Significance

Constructed for an Arkansas Negro college in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, Caldwell Hall was designed by the Thompson, Sanders and Ginocchio firm in 1928. This large, handsomely detailed building set amidst a large expanse of tree-shaded lawn is an impressive and dignified structure on this college campus. The generous cast stone trim (forming a lively contrast against the red brick walls) including quoins, Gibbs surrounds and the classical elements of the entryway create a formal, yet small-scale effect in this large building. The distinctive and eye-catching central panel with its Art Deco carved panels and streamlined piers reflect an unusual eclectic blend of Art Deco and Classical elements. A striking building set well off the highway which extends in front of it, Caldwell Hall is an attractive landmark on the southern Arkansas college campus.


