

Historic Sites Survey 6A

ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

One-and-a-half-story flanking-gable frame residence with pedimented tetrastyle portico. Inset gallery (partially enclosed) along rear (west) facade. Center hall plan; double parlors with centerpieces.

ALTERATIONS:

OUTBUILDINGS: Two barns located approximately one hundred feet northeast of house. Outbuildings no longer extant: smokehouse, potato house, slaves quarters, stables, carriage house, saddle house.

LANDSCAPE FEATURES: Hilltop setting. Curving drive from Greenwood Street between rolling, partially forested pastures.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

Collina is architecturally significant as a well-proportioned moderately sized Greek Revival country residence. Former home of Henry Hughes, author of Treatise on Sociology (1854), who died here in 1864.
