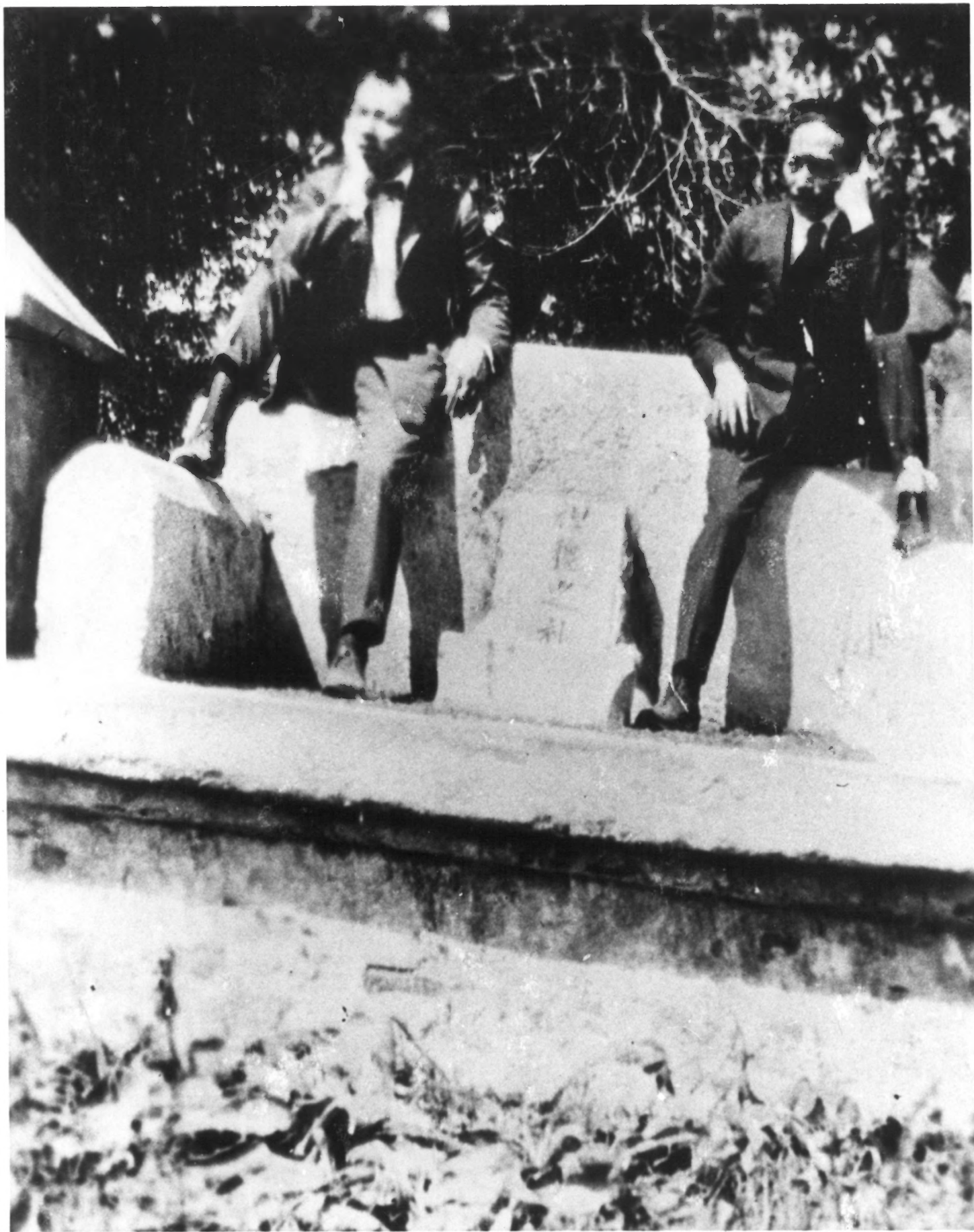

CHINATOWN

A 7-ACRE SETTLEMENT WAS FOUNDED HERE IN 1886 BY DUEY WO LUNG AND OTHER LEADERS OF RIVERSIDE'S PIONEER CHINESE. UNTIL 1900 THE POPULATION RARELY DROPPED BELOW 150 AND DURING THE CITRUS HARVEST OFTEN NUMBERED SEVERAL THOUSAND. THE BRICK BUILDING, ERECTED AFTER THE GREAT CHINATOWN FIRE OF JULY 31, 1893, IS THE LAST OF 26 ORIGINAL STRUCTURES ALONG CHINATOWN AVENUE.

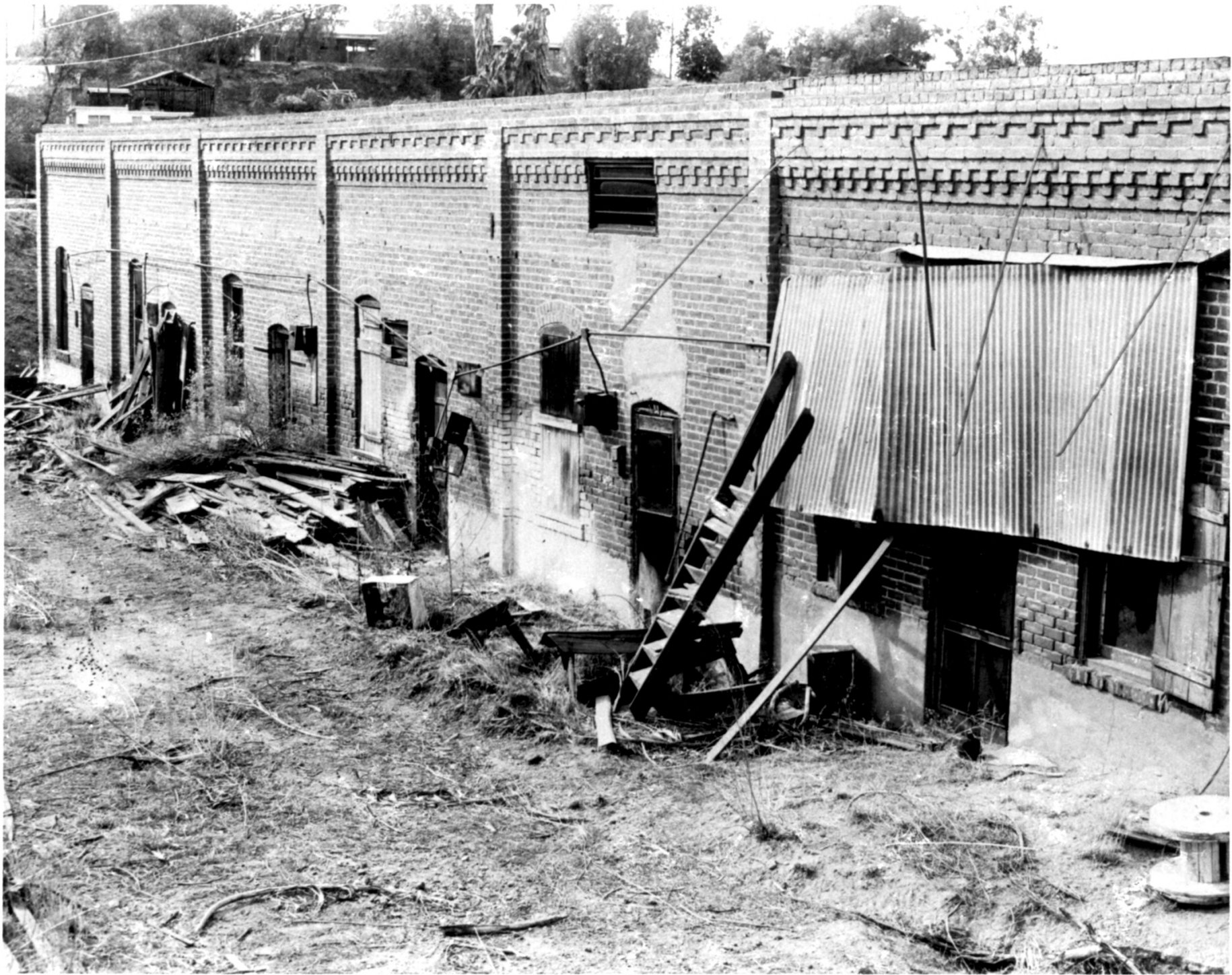

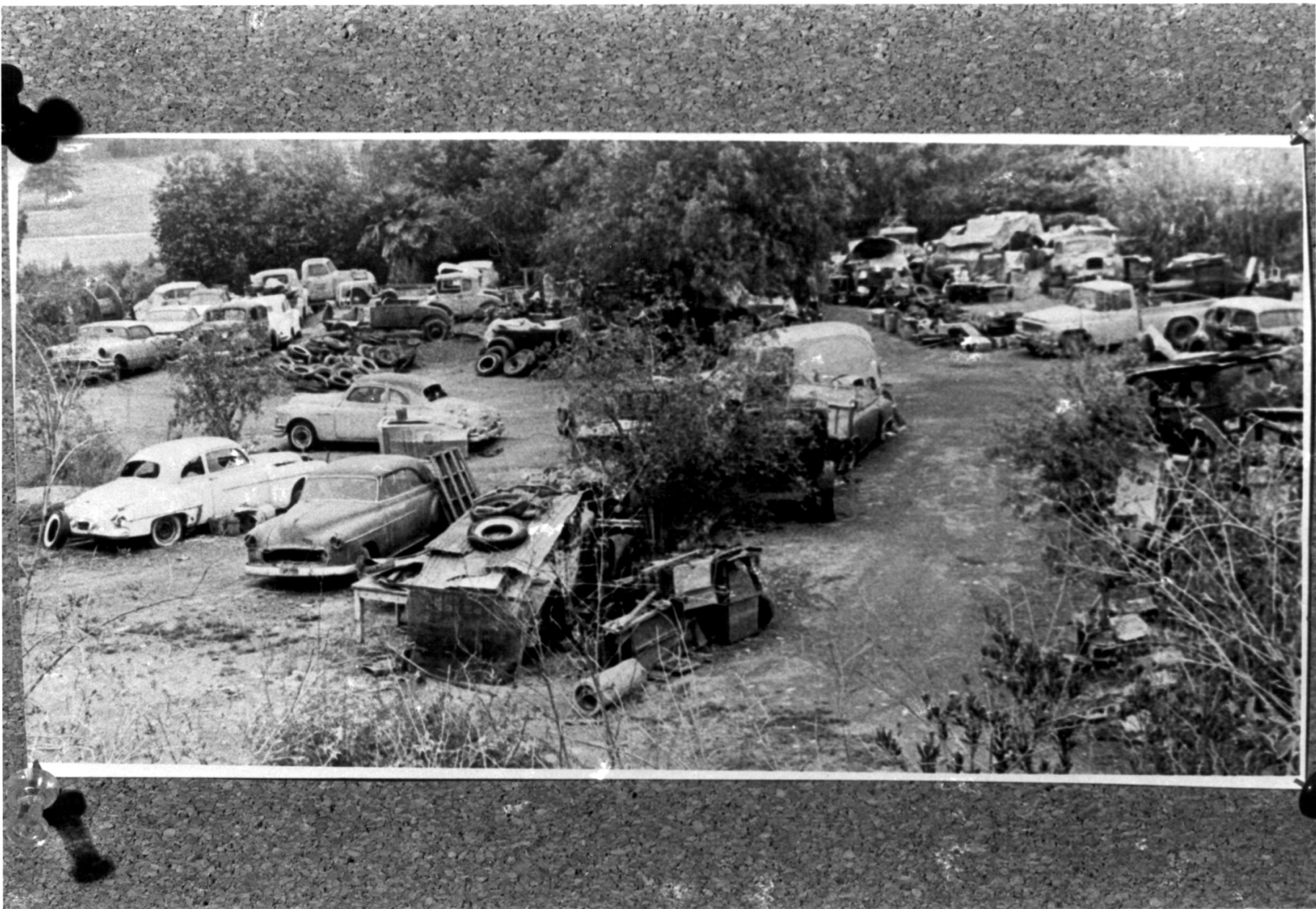

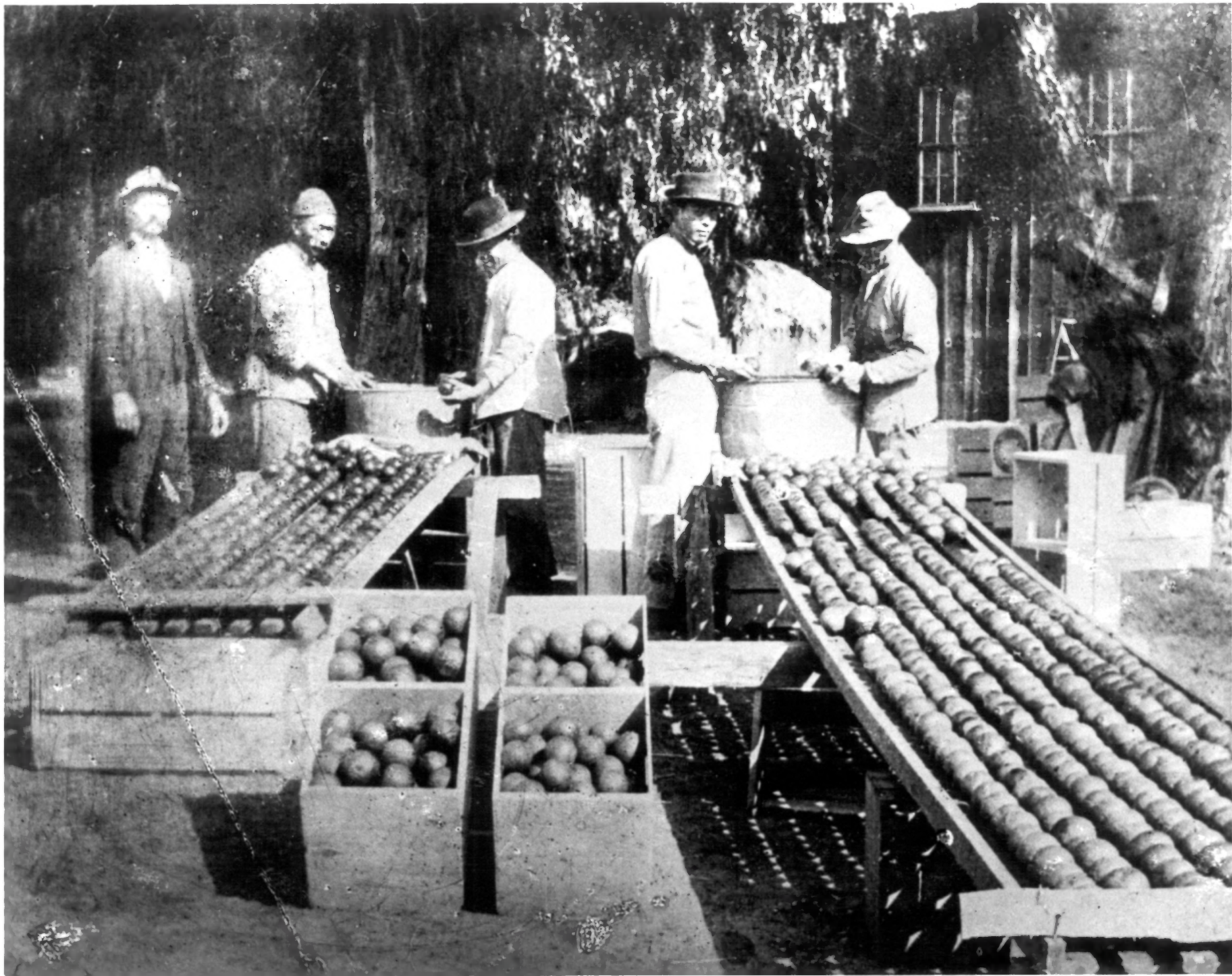

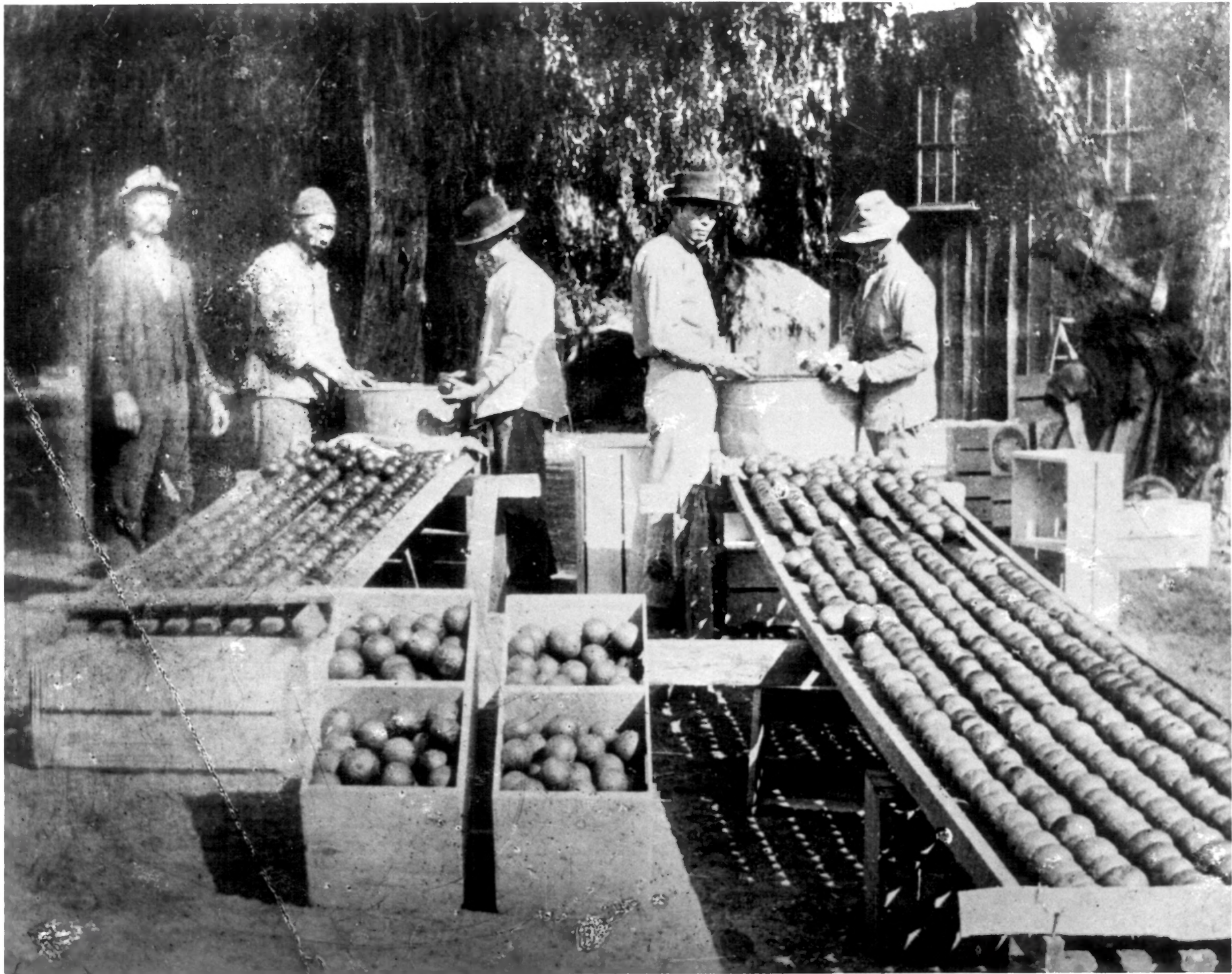

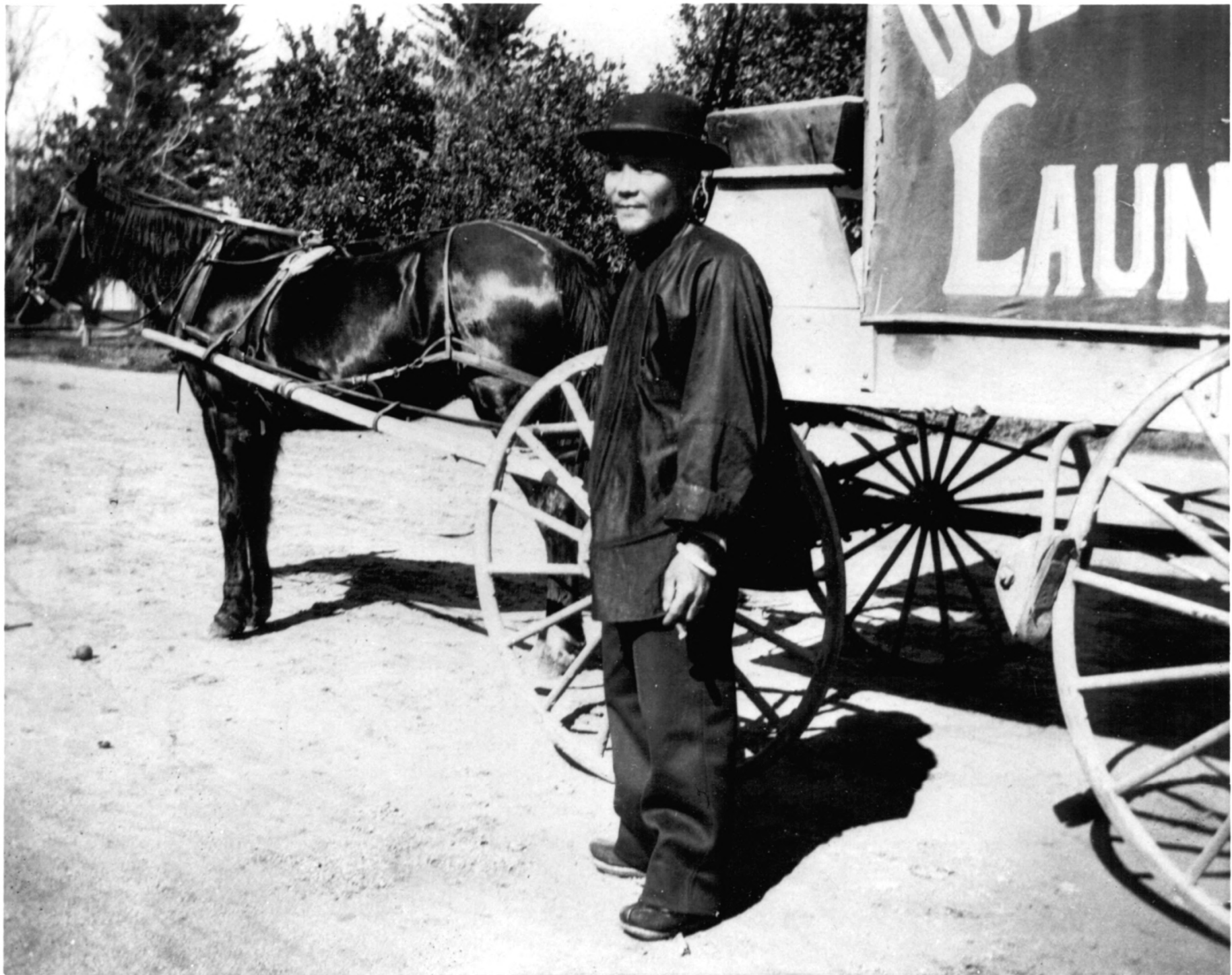
