The nominated property consists of a rectangle, 22 feet wide by 156 feet long, whose vertices coincide with the outside corners of the bridge abutments at each end of the bridge, and includes only the bridge superstructure and substructure.

Boundary Justification: See continuation sheet.

Because the bridge is located on a public road, there are no legal boundary lines for the ends of the bridge. Therefore, these boundaries are drawn to encompass only the superstructure and substructure of the bridge itself.

Bridge no. 58-140-224 is located 4 miles east and 2.6 miles north of Redfield and carries a local road over the James River. The 150-foot, steel, riveted, Parker (camelback) through truss bridge rests on standard State Highway Commission concrete abutments. The superstructure is composed as follows: the upper chords are two channel sections riveted with a continuous cover plate along the upper flanges and lacing bars along the lower flanges; the lower chords are two pairs of angle sections with batten plates; the verticals are two channel sections with lacing bars; the diagonals are two angle sections with batten bars. The concrete deck is supported by steel I-beam stringers which sit on top of I-beam floor beams. The floor beams are riveted to the vertical members below the lower chord. Portal and sway bracing consists of paired angle sections. Top and bottom lateral bracing consists of angle section cross-braces. The railings are composed of two channel sections.

The bridge retains excellent integrity.

8. Significance

Bridge no. 58-140-224 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1942" and is classified with the associated property type for iron and steel frame bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C as the oldest example of a riveted Parker through truss in South Dakota. The bridge retains excellent integrity.

Bridge No. 58-140-224 was constructed in 1919 by the Iowa Bridge Company. Of the thirteen riveted Parker through trusses surveyed state wide, this is the oldest surviving example in South Dakota.
