Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance

The Winn Road Schoolhouse stands in a rural setting surrounded by gently rolling farmland. The Greek Revival style structure is constructed of brick and has a granite foundation. The narrow gable end, which faces the street, has a full pediment with a date block in the tympanum. Located in the center of the principal elevation is an entrance with a six panel door. The windows, which are set beneath granite lintels, have six over six double-hung sash.

The building faces southwest.

Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)

The Winn Road School, built as a rural district school in 1846 by the Town of Cumberland is one of only two known one-room, brick, Greek Revival schoolhouses remaining in Maine, the other being also in Cumberland but considerably altered for use as a police station. Last used as a school in the early part of this century, in the past few years it has been used for various purposes by town and civic groups. Little remains of the building's original interior, but the replaced flooring retains a rare feature - a sloping floor - allowing a teacher to keep an eagle eye on activities even in the back row.

The building was recently sold at auction subject to a preservation easement which requires maintenance of the facade and prohibits demolition. The new owner plans to use it as a stained glass studio.
