VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A at the fence corner of the yard, thence N 100 ft to B, thence leaving fence at right angle E 120 ft to C at the telephone pole, thence S 100 ft to D, thence W with fence 120 ft to the beginning, about 1/4 acre.
No other old buildings are at site.
