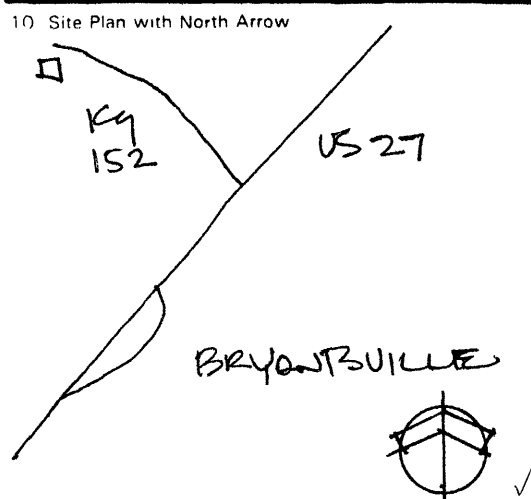

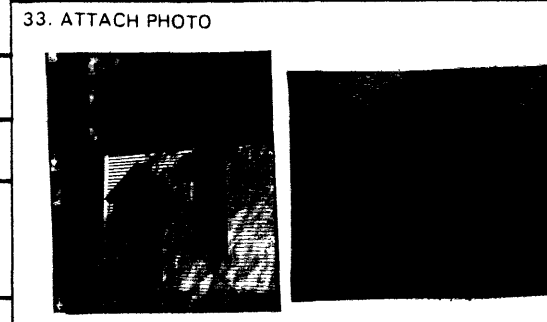

19. HISTORY (contd)

in the history of Walnutta Methodist Episcopal Church. The original church here was of stone, very low but with a floor space nearly as large as the present church.

The names of people constituting this church and the one at Bryantsville are very similar. It is possible that some people of this faith worshipped at White Oak Meetinghouse, which is, or was, on the same site as Harmony Presbyterian Church. White Oak Meetinghouse was probably built before 1800 and was a Union of Free Church where all sects had the right to worship.

It is believed that Mt. Olivet is the successor of Garrett's Chapel and the nearest to its site. This was surely near to where the Buena Vista Road enters the Lexington Road.

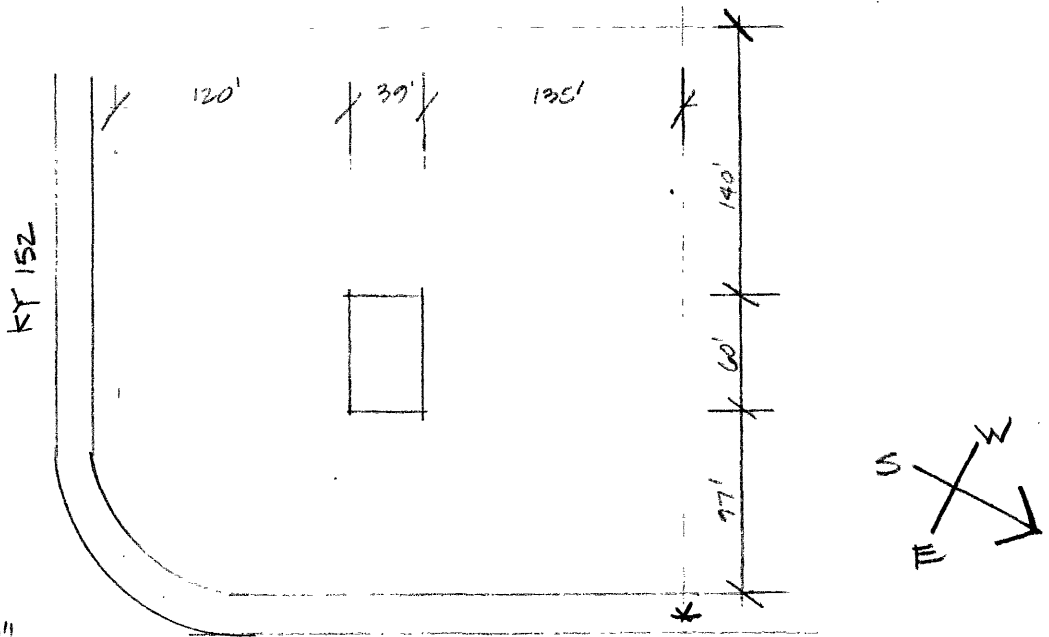

The point of beginning is 130 feet north and 97 feet east of the northeast corner of the Mt. Olivet Church.
