



Historic Sites Survey

ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: The Vancleave cottage is a one-story, wood frame, L-shaped building which rests on low brick piers and has a cross-gable roof. The facade consists of a projecting chamfered bay flanked by a shed-roofed porch which features turned posts, sawn brackets and a spindle frieze. The gables are clad in imbricated shingles. The two-over-two double-hung sash windows are set in simple architraves as is the transomed door which has a large glazed panel.

ALTERATIONS: Rear porch enclosure, iron railings added to porch, and vertical board sheathing attached to some interior wall surfaces. Possibly missing the brackets for the chamfered bay and some porch brackets.

LANDSCAPE FEATURES:

Crushed shell parking lot on the west side of the house, otherwise an open lawn with large trees.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: The Vancleave cottage is architecturally significant in the context of Ocean Springs as the most representative example of a residential building form which experienced pronounced and prolonged popularity in Mississippi during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, the Queen Anne Cottage. In its most compact form, as it is reflected by the Vancleave building, the Queen Anne Cottage consists of a one story rectangular block from the facade of which an asymmetrically-placed chamfered bay projects. The body of the building is covered by a cross gable roof and the porch which flanks the bay is shed or flat-roofed. The extent of the ornamentation varies but includes turned posts, sawn brackets and spindle friezes as porch decoration and imbricated shingles on the faces of the gables. The Vancleave cottage has retained all of these quintessentially Queen Anne Style features. Similar buildings have survived in Ocean Springs, however, they have lost significant

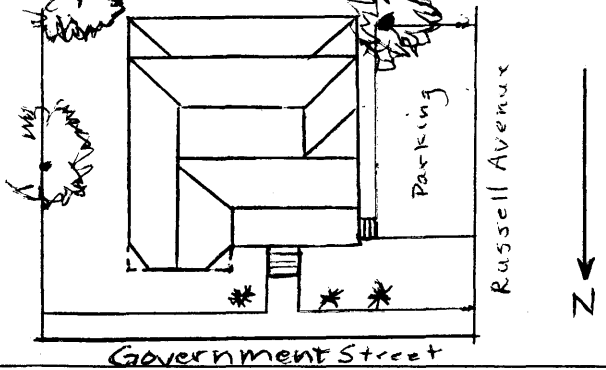
