


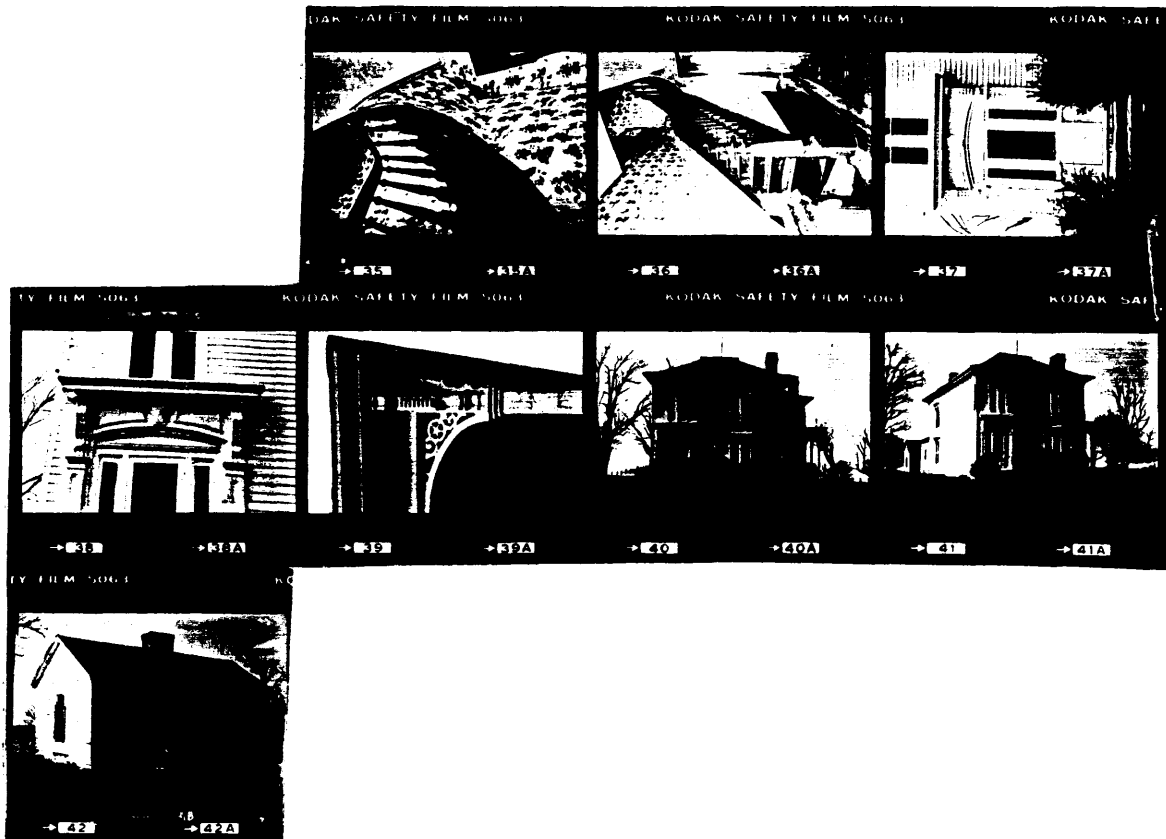

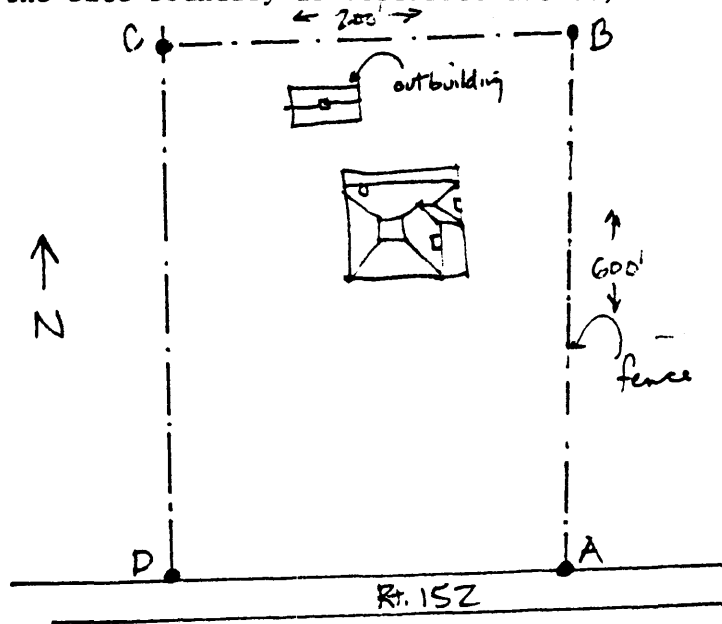

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage approx. 3 acres

Point A is located 350 feet southeast of the southeast corner of the house on the north side of Ky. 152. Beginning at Point A on the north side of Ky. 152, north along fence 600 feet along east of house to Point B, west 200 feet with fence to Point C, thence 600 feet south along a fence to Point D on Ky. 152, east along northside of Ky. 152, 200 feet to point of origin. The boundaries were drawn to include the house and domestic-related space within fences and the highway. A contributing frame outbuilding is included. The nominated area includes two contributing buildings.
