









PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION

A cottage 25' wide and 16' deep. The side facing Clawson Street has two rooms 12' x 12', each with own front door. The back of the house has a bathroom and kitchen each 4' x 12'. The front wall is board and the other three walls stucco. The roof is corrugated metal. A front porch stretches across the whole of the front of the house. Apart from the addition of a small bathroom and kitchen, probably around 1920, the exterior of the house is unaltered. The house has been renovated so it has become an attractive addition to the historic district.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE/HISTORY

While it has no individual or particular significance, this cottage is archetypal of simple copper miner's dwellings built at the turn of the century. As built in 1908, it had only two rooms 12' x 12'. Each room had a separate front door suggesting occupancy by separate individuals or families. The cottage did not have a kitchen or bathroom although these were added some years after construction, probably around 1920.

Bisbee lot 3, block 9 (#75). 100' x 25'. The property is entered on Clawson Street and stretches to Howell Street. To the west is an empty lot and to the east a single-family residence.

This property lies within the historic district of Old Bisbee but was left off the map of listed properties because of its poor condition. However, it has now been refurbished to become an extremely comfortable small residence so it now deserves inclusion among the listed properties.
