Verbal Boundary Description:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Building #2009 (present Star Ranger Station office) and proceeding on azimuth $300^{\circ}/92$ feet to Point A (a point on the west edge of the Upper Applegate county road); then along the west edge of the road on azimuth $210^{\circ}/145$ feet to Point B (near the junction of county road and driveway to Building #2004); then due north $0^{\circ}/180$ feet to Point C; then due east $90^{\circ}/60$ feet to Point D; and then returning $165^{\circ}/56$ feet to Point A.
