This is a two story Doric hexastyle building with full inscribed entablature and pediment with a semi-circular light. On the entry porch there are pressed metal ceilings and a balcony that is four bays wide and engages the columns. Corners of the building have colossal pilasters. Rectangular windows with stone lintels surround the whole.

The courtroom has a lowered ceiling; acoustical tile has been added. The balcony remains open; the bench is plain. Plaster walls, asbestos tile and terrazzo floors are used throughout.




