


19. History (Continued)

There were many transactions , but this land was in the Dunn family since 1886. In 1948 T. E. English Dunn sold to Allen Sharp , and it has remained in the Sharp family.

The land across the road from the Dunn land (Sharp now) belonged to George Moore (Carrie Nation's father) and was sold to the Brights who married into the Dunn family. Thus many acres in this area belonged to the Dunn family.

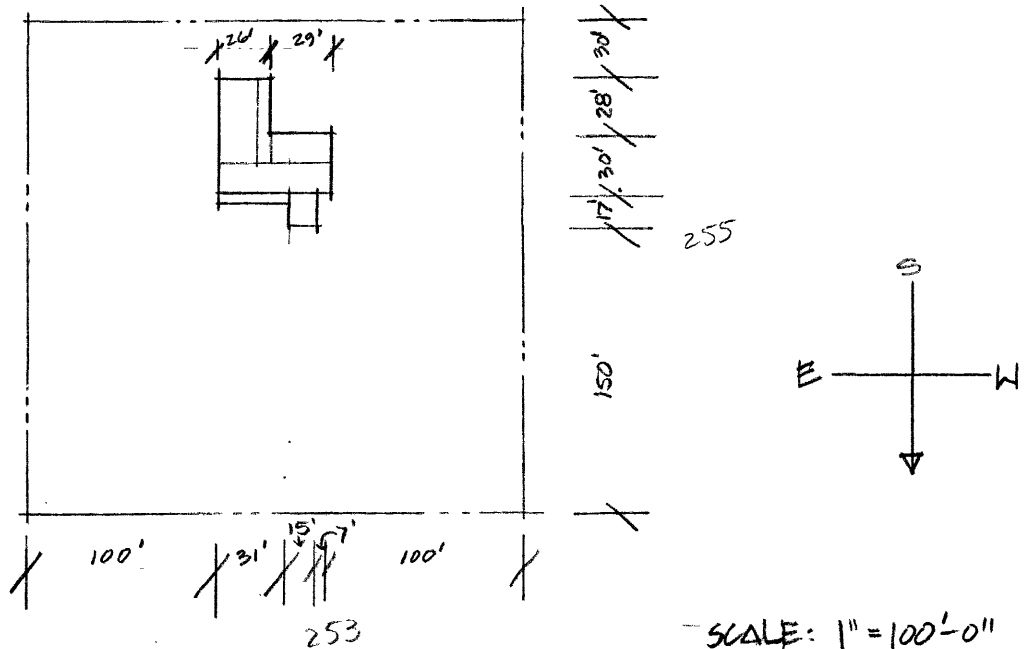

From a point 800 feet South of the Fisher Ford Road; then 253 feet East to a point; then 255 feet South to a point; then 253 feet West to a point; then 255 feet North to the point of beginning.

The point of beginning is 150 feet north and 100 feet west of the northwest corner of the house.
