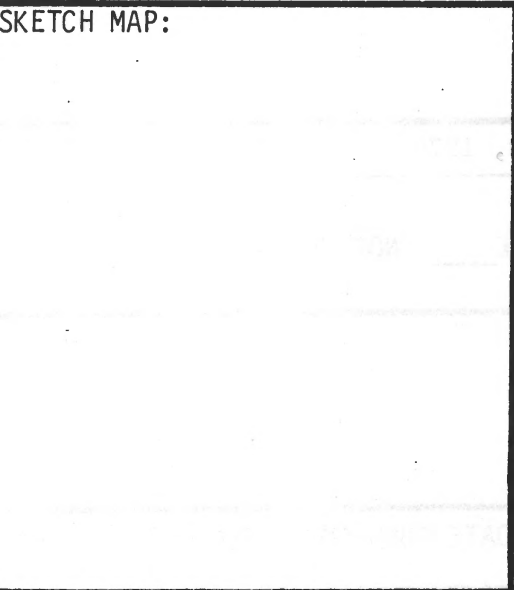

PROMINENT OCCUPANT/HISTORIC ASSOCIATION(S) Norman Hale was an expert stone contractor working in and around Kingman during the late 1890s and early 1900s.

RELATIONSHIP TO LOCAL DEVELOPMENT First fraternal lodge in Kingman. Important to city social/cultural development.

ARCHITECTURAL STYLE Only example of Richardsonian Romanesque Revival influence in Ki

DISCUSSION AS REQUIRED:

Has been in use as Elks Lodge since 1904 construction. Originally first story was used as an opera house. Building was initially financed and occupied by Elks Lodge, IOOF, and Knights of Pythias.

Oldest lodge building in Kingman. Stone from Metcalfe Quarry near Kingman.
