

Physical Description

Occupying a spacious lot and shaded by the surrounding huge trees, this one-and-a-half story house with basement is characterized by a horizontal orientation. The spreading rectangular block of the house is capped by a tile gable end roof; on the northeast end a screened-in porch with a separate roof projects. The spreading, rectangular mass is capped by a tile gable roof and enlivened on the front elevation by a dormer with steep gable roof, a slightly projecting screened-in porch on the northeast end, and adjacent to the recessed entrance, by a prominent three-sided bay. The roofscape is enlivened by the roof of this bay which features a three-sided roof rising to a peak. The small front porch is open with only a low brick wall capped with cast stone defining it. Craftsman-influenced details include the exposed rafters, the pseudo half-timbering lining the dormer, and the large curved brackets which frame the entry and the screened-in porch opening. The front door features a full-length multi-paned window flanked by two short multi-paned sidelights. The sash windows have six-over-one lights.

Statement of Significance

Designed by the Thompson and Harding firm in 1919, the Thane House in Arkansas City is suited to its spectacular setting near the Mississippi River. The long, horizontal orientation of the Thane House is somewhat unusual in the Craftsman house designs represented in the collection of drawings. The horizontal emphasis was no doubt influenced by the river oriented setting. Located on a slightly elevated parcel of land adjacent to the Mississippi River, the Thane House is a spreading rectangular block of brick construction capped by a tile roof. The Thane House features one of the most spectacular settings of this group of properties.
