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Description

The J. M. McCall House is a white-painted, single-story, wood-frame residence constructed c. 1910 in the Craftsman-style of architecture. A continous foundation, now stuccoed, supports the frame walls, which are sheathed with false-bevel novelty siding. A composition-shingled gable roof with exposed rafters covers the structure. There are no extant chimneys.

The front, or western, elevation features a full-facade porch recessed beneath the main gable roof, which is supported by four wood columns, square and tapered, on a short, novelty sided wall. The porch deck is formed of a raised concrete platform and is accessed by five concrete steps. A single wood door, with a three-pane light, is placed just north of the center elevation and is flanked by two one-over-one double-hung windows. Five relatively ornate, scrolled brackets support the otherwise simple projecting gable end. A pair of replacement wood-louvered vents is placed in the center near the peak.

A projecting gable bay dominates the northern elevation. It is adorned by three of the decorative brackets and is fenestrated by a group of three one-over-one double-hung windows. An identical group of windows is positioned on the wall to the west of this bay, while a solitary one-over-one window lights the room to the east of the bay.

The rear, or eastern, elevation originally had an inset porch on the southeastern corner. This has been enclosed with drop siding with a single-leaf entrance near the center of the elevation. Otherwise, a small boarded-over window to the north and a pair of louvered vents completes the description of this elevation.

The southern elevation contains two groups of three one-over-one double-hung one-over-one windows and a small three-over-one window in the enclosed rear porch section.

The interior was not viewed.

Located on Spring Street in Marshall, the J. M. McCall House is in fair condition.

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Significance

Although little is known about the original occupant of this house, J. M. McCall, other than he was the principal of the Leslie High School at some point in his career, the J. M. McCall House is eligible under Criterion C as a locally significant and unique example of the Craftsman style. This residence was constructed c. 1910 when the Craftsman style was just gaining popularity in Arkansas, especially in the more rural regions of the state. As completed, the J. M. McCall House reflects many traits of the Plain Traditional style such as the simple and basically straight gable-roof floor plan and one-over-one windows. The new Craftsman style is seen in the exposed rafters, the tapered wood columns, and the projecting gable bay on the northern elevation. Most significant, however, and indicative of a previous era of architectural detail are the delicate, scrolled brackets that are positioned in the Craftsman manner, but are much more ornate than the almost universal triangular knee brackets found in later examples of this style.


