A simple 1 1/2 story, gable-roofed frame building, the First Kindergarten is located on a gently sloping hillside on the grounds of the Richards Octagon House. Cornices are boxed, with common metal eaves along the sides. Siding is of clapboards, and all openings have plain board trim. Windows are plain, wood-muntined, double hung sash. The building is small, approximately 18 feet wide and 24 feet long. It is well maintained and in reasonably good condition. Its continued preservation is assured.

In the years prior to 1956 the building had seen a variety of uses, the most recent being that of a store. The front gable end had been much altered to make it a store front. Original clapboarded sides had been covered with a simulated brick sheathing. What interior modifications might have occurred are not known.

Because the building faced demolition in late 1956 it was moved by the Watertown Historical Society to a permanent location on the Octagon House grounds and faithfully restored to its original state. The interior is one large room, furnished as a kindergarten school room would have appeared when it was used for that purpose—a living room used as a classroom—and, with manikins, portrays a kindergarten class in progress.
