## DESCRIPTION:

This cross plan courthouse sits on a tiny square in the center of Warrenton. It has an amphi-prostyle tetrastyle in-antis facade with projecting corner pavilions. Crisp white detailing contrasts with the red brick. Four double door entrances remain in use. Rectangular windows with flat arched lintels are used on both stories. Interior chimneys remain and the hipped roof has a shallow octagonal dome with knobbed cupola. Light from the dome reaches the courtroom through translucent glass covering a square opening in the pressed metal ceiling. Wooden wainscoting surrounds the plaster walls. The original judge's bench has been replaced by a plywood one.
