

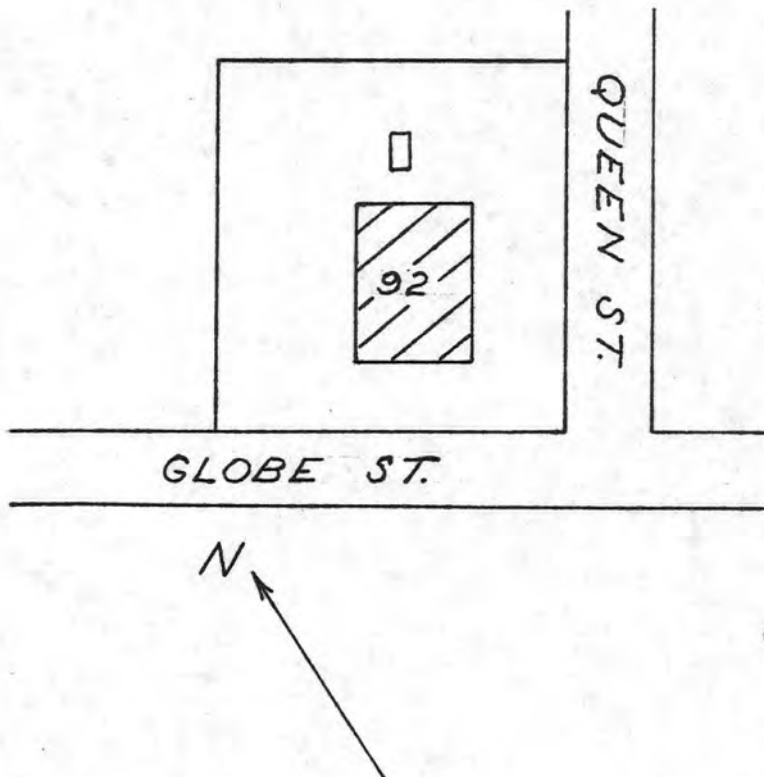

9. Historical significance (include explanation of themes checked above)

This two-story mansard cottage, intact in <sup>almost</sup> all its detail, is the most high-style structure in an area dominated by multi-family structures. Ariadne and Mary Borden, sisters who were both principals of Grammar Schools, built this cottage and lived here with a brother, Andrew J. Borden II. They are only distant relatives of Andrew J. Borden (Lizzie's father.)

This structure is the best example of the small 2-story mansard cottages in Fall River. Although a late example (this style became popular c. 1871) it is a wonderfully exuberant one. It retains its integrity of design; materials, workmanship and setting, and meets Criteria A and C of the National Register.
