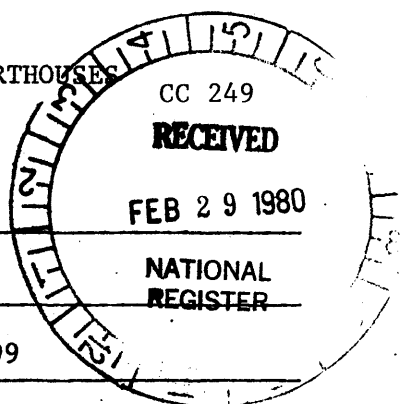

DESCRIPTION:

Style: Romanesque

Facade Material: Brick with stone and pressed metal trim.

Some work on the building was recently completed.

Boundary: The northern portion of the block on which the courthouse sits being bounded on the N,E, and W by streets and on the S by a line running approx. 20 feet from the bldg.

Acreage: less than one

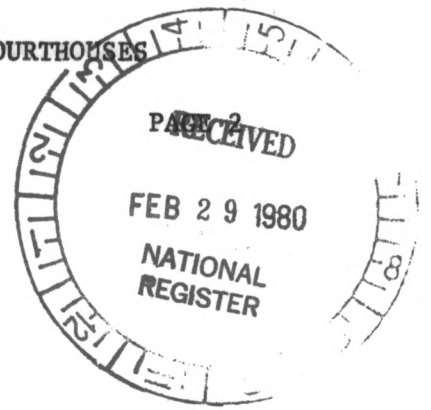
This design is similar to Golucke courthouses in Union, Henry, Baker, and Jones counties. All have a cross plan and tall, capped clock towers, with the arch motif repeated throughout in both the interiors and exteriors. Corner turrets are used on the towers and the corners of the buildings.

The two story courthouse is a rectangular block topped by a hipped roof with intersecting gables. The central two stage tower has an open belvedere and clock dormers set in a pyramidal cap. Round arched windows and rectangular windows are used on both the first and second story. A stringcourse divides the 1st and 2nd floors. The facade has matching two story pedimented pavilions framing a projecting one story closed entrance porch with a round arched door. On the second floor, the pavilions contain triple blind arcades separated by pilasters.

A beautiful pressed metal ceiling is evident in the balcony of the courtroom -- the ceiling of the courtroom has been covered with acoustical tile.

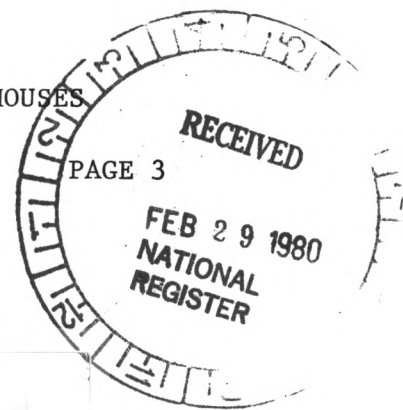
