One-story, irregularly massed, turn-of-the-century frame cottage facing west. Moderately pitched hipped roof with a gable projection and a four- bay pavilion at the southwest corner. Main entrance is a single door with transom. A single four-over-four double-hung sash completes fenestration. L-shaped porch from western to northern facade leads to secondary entrance, a single door with transom. Balustraded porch with slender posts and decorative brackets. The Stogner House, 550 North Cherry, along with its almost identical neighbors at 515 and 560 North Cherry, is a highly-articulate example of an intricately-detailed, middle-class, turn-of-the-century cottage in Magnolia. The three closely grouped residences maintain a perfect scale and relationship along North Cherry Street, and both individually and collectively, are significant for their historic streetscape, attention to Eastlake detail, and high degree of preservation. These cottages are the smallest extant residences constructed during Magnolia's turn-of-the- century building boom and show an extraordinary commitment to the decorative details expressed in Magnolia's magnificent Queen Anne residences.
