THE MERCANTILE AT SOUTHVILLE HAS AN OVER 100 YEAR LINK TO THE HISTORY OF RURAL SHELBY COUNTY. IN 1882 AT THIS SITE, WAS A STORE AND POST OFFICE OPERATED BY J.H. CARRIS. CARRIS' ADVERTISEMENT INDICATED HE WAS THE PROPRIETOR OF BOTH A SAWMILL AND FEEDMILL WITH "ALL KINDS OF LUMBER TO ORDER, AND WILL GRIND CORN AT ANY TIME TO ACCOMMODATE HIS CUSTO-THIS BUILDING IS NOT THE LATE 19TH CENTURY ONE, BUT WAS BUILT CA. 1915 AND OPERATED BY THE RICHARDSON FAMILY.

44. Site Plan (and boundary description and justification for N.R. sites):

The property boundary of Carriss's Grocery is a rectangle around the perimeter walls of the building. The southeast corner of the boundary is located by the northwest corner of the intersection of KY 44 and KY 53 in Southville, 15'southeast of the southeast corner of the building. From this point, follow the north edge of KY 44 west to a point 25'west of the west wall of the building; then north along a line 25' west of and parallel to the west wall of the building to a point 25' north of the north wall of the building; then follow a line 25' north of and paralle to the north wall to the west edge of KY 53, then south along the west edge of the road to the point of origin.

45. Description and House Plan:

The Southville/ Carriss's grocery is prominently located on the northwest corner of the only intersection in the community of Southville. Here, at the junction of KY 53 (Mt. Eden Road) and KY 44 (Hempridge Road), the store, feedstore (SH 22B) and several frame residences anchor the crossroads with a community over 100 years acld, The setting, of which the store is a major feature, is undoubtedly rural.

The building presents a rather generic appearance: one main, rectangulr room; gable roof with metal clad porch suspended from the front gable end by guy lines; an elevated, stone front loading dock/porch; four-over-four sash windows; a recessed central front entry and clapboard siding. Overall, the building measures 25' by 75'. The interior, old, if not original, has a wood floor, kitchen grill, a couple of tables and shelves, both free standing and built in. The property contains one contributing building.
