


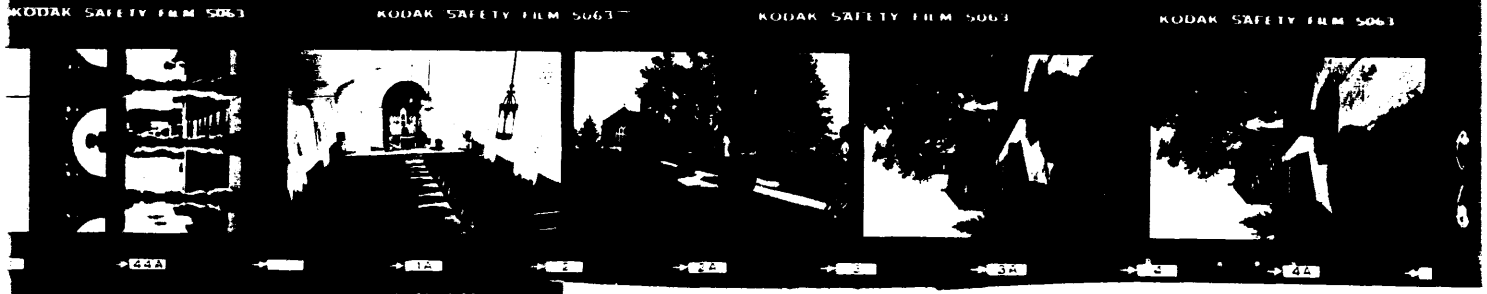

DESCRIPTION: (cont.) slopes; nave has natural color slate roof.

HISTORY: (cont.) 25' x 65' and situated on an elevated spot south of town on what is presently known as Armory Hill. The church was served by the Dominican fathers. Previous to the frame church the congregation apparently attended St. Rose which began c. 1808 and St. Ann's. St. Ann's, built on Cartwright's Creek, was a log structure torn down in 1819.

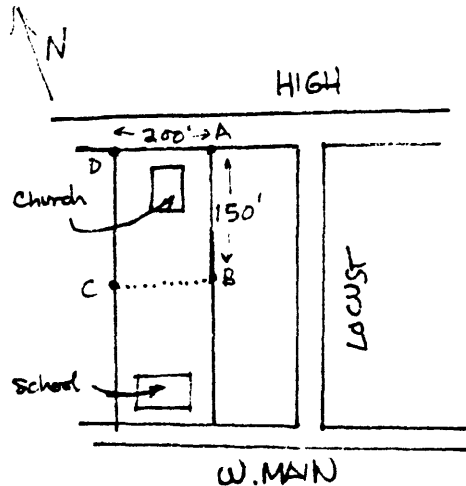

Verbal Boundary Description

Acreage less than 1 acre

Rear (north) half of lot #B12-5. Beginning at point A on the south side of High Street, proceeding south 150' to point B, thence 200' west to point C, thence 150' north to point D, thence 200' east to the point of origin. The property contains one contributing and no noncontributing building. The boundaries were selected to include the church and its immediate landscaped surroundings.
