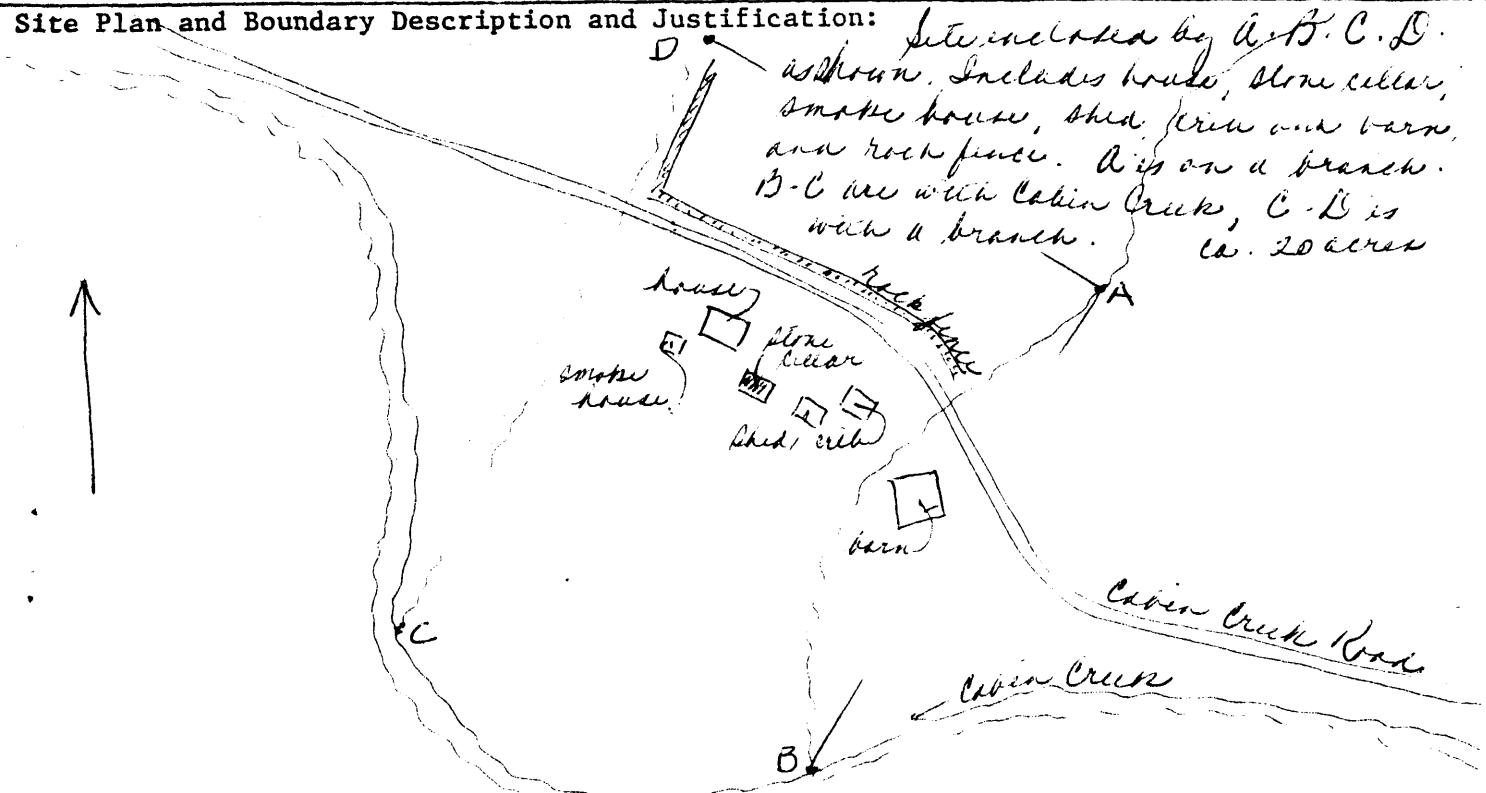

44. Description and House Plan:  
One story dry stone cellar, ca. 16' X 20'. Upper Ordovician limestone, stones tooled and coursed, original limestone mortar. Gables, framed & weather-board. Eaves and rake extend.

Located behind mid-late 19th century frame I-house with interior end chimneys. Several old farm buildings at site--smokehouse, shed, crib and barn. Rock fence along road in front of house.

Farm is in valley of Cabin Creek. Several log houses and covered bridge nearby.
