


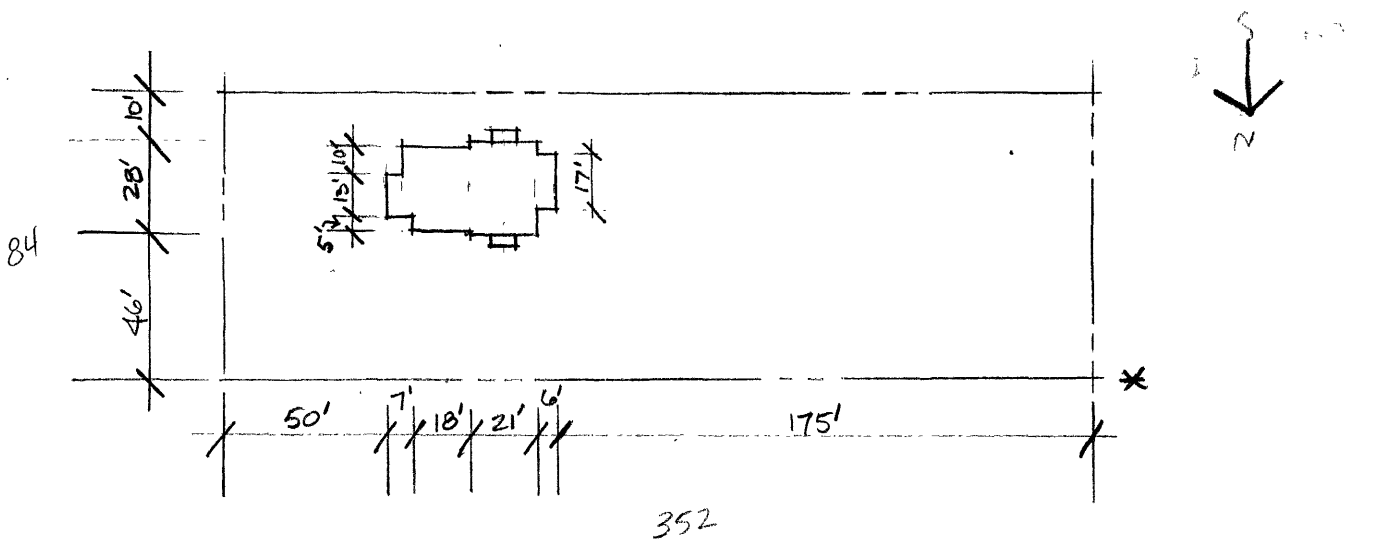

From a point .3 miles East of Locust Lane, then South 84 feet to a point; then East 279 feet to a point; then North 84 feet to a point; then West 279 feet to the point of beginning.

The point of beginning is 175 feet west and 46 feet north of the northwest corner of the William Parks House.
