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Description: The Colored Soldiers Monument in the Greenhill Cemetery is a limestone obelisk-like monument. It does not have the pyramidal point at the top that most obelisks have, but its is a vertical shaft with a top that is wider than the shaft. It is approximately ten feet tall and is inscribed on all four faces. The front reads: "Erected by Woman's Relief Corps No. 8 GAR July 1924. Monument Com. E. T. Strauss, President, N. C. Coleman, Sec., L. C. Redding, Mary L. Brooks, Clara C. McWilliams, Susan Butcher, Sallie Handy, Kate Richardson." Below this is a crossed rifle and U.S. flag. Below this is the inscription: "In Memory of the Colored Soldiers Franklin County, Kentucky Who Fought in the Civil War 1861-1865." The remaining three faces of the monument are inscribed with the 140 names of the men. The monument rests on a base of poured concrete.

Statement of Significance: The Colored Soldiers Monument meets National register Criterion A and is significant within the context of "Civil War Monuments in Kentucky, 1861-1935." This monument was erected in 1924 by the Women's Relief Corps of the Grand Army of the Republic, GAR. This is the only monument in the state erected to any of the nearly 30,000 Kentucky African American troops who served in the Union army. This monument erected in 1924, was late in the monumentization process. It is said to have been funded by both black and white citizens of Franklin County.

Verbal Boundary Description - The Color Soldier's Monument whose boundaries form a circle with a radius of ten feet centered on the monument located in Greenhill Cemetery.

Verbal Boundary Justification - The area associated with the monument is restricted to the ground on which the monument sits and a small buffer around it. The setting outside such a restricted area is not seen as critically important to maintaining an integrity of association. Because the focus of the multiple property submissions is the significance of the monuments, their proposed area of listing will reflect that they have been considered by-and-large, in isolation from their surrounds.
