Description:

The 1903 cream-colored brick Church of St. Stephen is similar in style and construction to the St. Anna Church. The granite foundation and detailing and central tower with an octagonal spire are seen on both churches. Windows in the church are round-arched. The brick rectory has a rectangular plan and a steep pyramidal roof. A screened porch extends across the front. The rectory is located immediately behind the church.
