

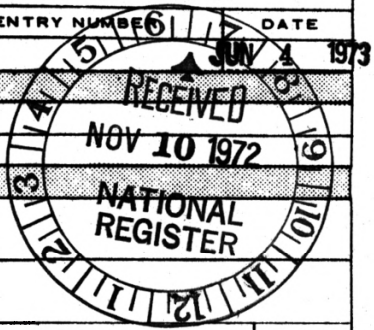

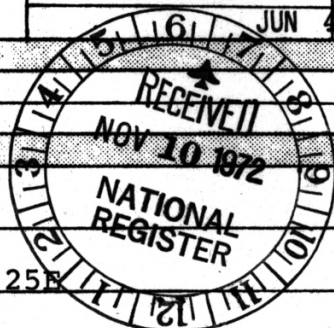

THE SITES OF FORT OKANOGAN

1 The pole in the distance seen through the right hand sighting device marks the site of the Fort Okanogan of John Jacob Astor's Pacific Fur Company. It was established by David Stuart in 1811 near the mouth of the Okanogan River.

2 The pole in the distance seen through the left hand sighting device marks the site of the Fort Okanogan of the Hudson's Bay Company. It was established and later moved to the bank of the Columbia River in the 1830's.
