In overall dimensions, the building is 30 feet wide and 45 feet deep. The plan is irregular in shape. Jigsawed located under the central gable. SIGNIFICANCE J.S. "Whistling Jack" Detwiler was a well-known engineer on the Railroad at the turn of the century.
