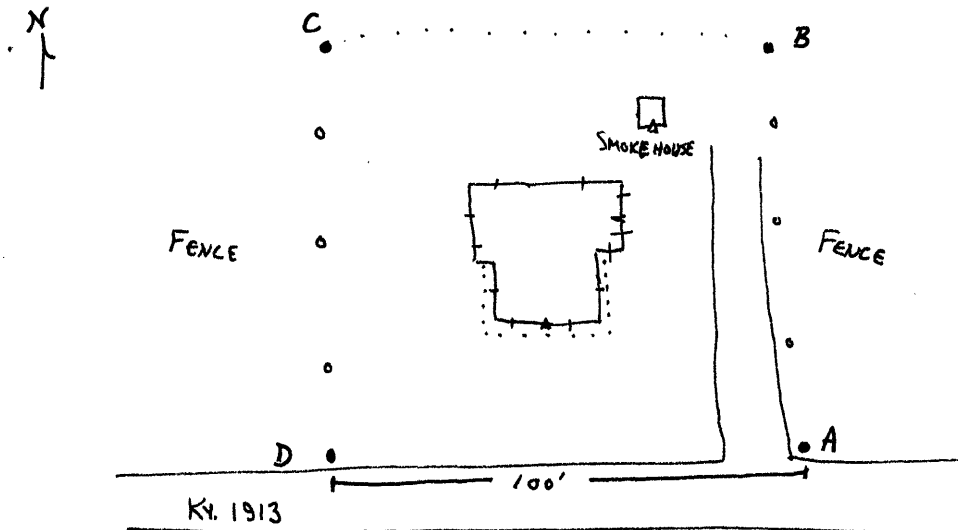

Beginning at point A, a fence post on the N side of Ky 1913, approximately 30' from the SE corner of the house; thence N along a fence line to point B; thence due W to point C in a fence line approximately 30' from the NW corner of the house; thence S along a fence line to point D, a corner post on the N side of Ky. 1913; thence to the beginning, approximately 100' along the N edge of Ky. 1913.
