VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A in the SE corner of the yard, thence 175 ft W with fence to B, thence 165 ft N with fence to C, thence 177 ft E with fence to D, thence 170 ft S to the beginning, containing the stone house, addition and stone dependency - about 2/3 acre
