PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION

This is a one-story rectangular stuccoed adobe commercial building with a gabled metal roof behind a curved parapet. The two-bay parapet is defined by three pilasters. A flat canopy cantilevers from the parapet midheight of the front facade. Two contemporary bays replace the original storefronts with a T-shaped entry on the east and an aluminum single glass panel door with sidelight and fixed glass square window on one side to the west. A shed gable roofed addition extends from the rear. The east wall bell-curves at the base, the stucco covering the remains of an adjacent wall. Also on the east, a rectangular opening appears to be infilled.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE/HISTORY

This unique store-front commercial building has a significant impact on Casa Grande's architectural fabric because of its unique parapet design. Rebuilt after the 1914 fire using the earlier adobe walls, the building was embellished with a Mission-style parapet, setting the style for later small commercial buildings in Casa Grande. The vaulted form once connected to a single vaulted parapet of an adjacent building to the west which had a similar design. Earlier photographs indicate a shed-roofed wood arcade extending across the front of this and the adjacent building. The building maintains its integrity and is little changed from its 1914 appearance. It has been in continual use as a commercial building.
