DESCRIPTION *Building at 500 Flynn Street,*

~~Korner Cigar Store~~ (500 Flynn). Built in 1905 this building is two stories high and of commercial type. It has a crenellated roofline. There are sixteen upper story windows--three on the front and thirteen on the north side. Pilaster strips frame the windows into groups of one, two or three. The upper story windows are narrow and rectangular. There is a cantilevered awning separating the upper and lower stories. The lower story has a glass entrance and small square glass windows in front and a series of eight very small windows high off the ground on the north side.

SIGNIFICANCE

This building is of a larger, more elaborate Plains Commercial architecture. During territorial times it was a drugstore. It boasted a modern fountain service as one of its main attractions. It was a prominent gathering place of the citizenry of the community. Architecturally, the building demonstrates the prosperity of the town, besides adding to the general townscape. ✓
