45. Description and House Plan:

Four-bay, two-story (off)-center-passage, dry-stone house on high basement, size ca. 20 x 48. Interior gable end chimneys, 5 - 7 stone voussoirs, water table. Masonry of Laurel Dolomite; laid in regular courses, squared, best on front. Front door in second bay; doors also in west end and rear, first floor, and in west end to cellar; attic windows flanking chimneys. Had pegged frames, ovolo trim, squared sills, replaced on front. Front door trim reeded with square corner blocks having concentric squares (photo 4). Tapered beaded vergeboard; cornice returned on front. Rear of house, three-bay with center second-floor window at landing level (as at HR-118).

Interior retains fine Federal woodwork: reeded pilaster mantel with breakfront and dentils, carved step ends, square banisters, chair rail. One-story, shed roofed addition across rear and one-story, shed roofed garage added on east end. Masonry repointed with concrete, square joints.

House faces south above draw created by spring branch to Rowan Creek on northwest. One spring is southeast of house, another, southwest of house, emerges from a 1,000 feet deep cave, large enough for fifty cattle. Rocks for house were quarried northwest of house.

Barns on the farm were constructed in 1914 from lumber cut from the original log horse barn.

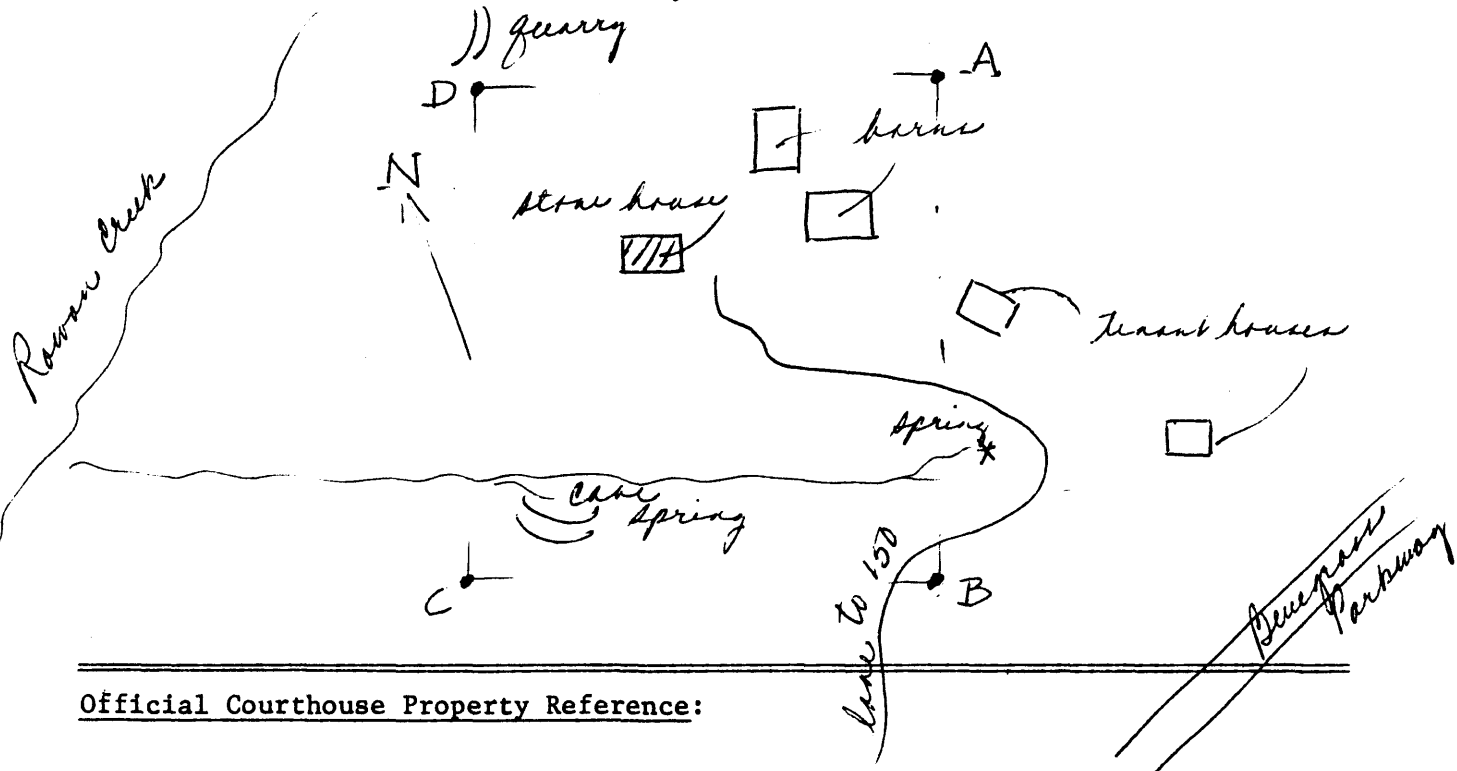
