DESCRIPTION:

The house at 247 Pleasant Avenue, essentially a hip-roofed classic cottage with three gabled or hipped extensions, is a one-story American colonial revival-influenced design with pedimented gables, molding tucked under its eaves and pent roofs, and thin molded door and window heads. White shiplap sheathes the exterior, contrasting with mint green trim. A hip-roofed porch is offset on the facade, shading the panel door and front one-over-one window. The foundation is obscured by a baseboard. The roof, shingled with grey asphalt, is topped by a brick chimney with a single outset course. A matching gable-roofed garage of white shiplap with green trim sits to the rear of the house.

SIGNIFICANCE: The house at 247 Pleasant Avenue is an elaboration of the classic cottage that in massing is more suggestive of Queen Anne architecture but in details evokes the colonial revival. The house's fully closed gable pediments, enclosed eaves, and near symmetry are representative of Challis domestic architecture generally. In addition, this house remains very nearly unaltered, the only change being a newer roof.
