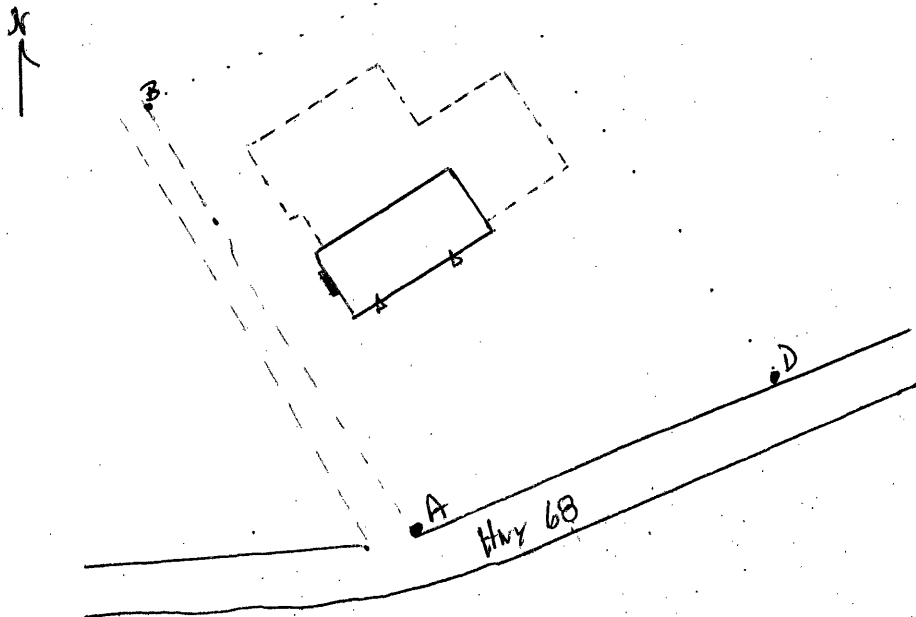
Verbal Boundary Description

Acreage .37 ACRES

Bounded on S by Hwy 68, on W by lane approximately 30' to W of house,
and on N and E by imaginary line establishing 30' right of way.

Beginning at point A, the intersection of a lane and Hwy 68, approximately 60' from the SW corner of the house, thence NW along said lane to point B 120'; thence E along an imaginary line 30' from the bounded house 120' to point C; thence S 130' to point D at the N edge of Hwy 68; thence along the N edge of Hwy 68 to the beginning.
