Description

The Sanders-Hollabaugh House is a single-story, wood frame interpretation of the traditional house type known as the "prow" house. The typical "T"-shaped floor plan is augmented by the shed roofed porch that wraps around the southern end of the "T", and which in this case is echoed by the three-sided wall bay beneath. The projecting gables to the eastern and western sides are fenestrated with a single central window on each, and the northern elevation is punctuated with two single-leaf doors symmetrically-placed between two one-over-one windows. There are no chimneys. The metal roof and weatherboarded walls are supported by a continuous stone foundation.

The only detail of note are the turned wood posts that support the porch roof and the diagonal weatherboarding set into the gable peak above the porch roof.

Also included in the nomination is a small, single-story, gable roof, board-and-batten building that covers the well.

Significance

Criterion C, local significance

The Sanders-Hollabaugh House, constructed in 1903 by the builders Noel Watts and someone known only as "Mr. Garrison," was built as part of a planned addition to the city of Marshall known as the Bratton Addition, named for Ben Bratton, the man who developed it. It was first owned by the Sanders family, who sold it to the Hollabaugh family that owns it currently.

The Sanders-Hollabaugh House is one of the best examples in the county of this particular traditional house type, known as a "prow" house. Its construction date of 1903 and its distinctive traditional type represent the historic context Searcy County History, 1865-1910: Reconstruction, Railroads and Renewal. As noted in this context, this was a period of county-wide growth and prosperity, relatively speaking, and thus a period during which there was much new immigration and new construction. The county seat of Marshall, with its county courthouse and its propitious location on the Missouri and North Arkansas Railroad, looked forward to many years of growth and prosperity. With its traditional "T"-shaped floor plan and three-sided wrap-around porch, the Sanders-Hollabaugh House is thus eligible with local significance under Criterion C as the best and most well-preserved example of this ostensibly plain but nevertheless distinctive residential style in Marshall during this period.


