returned on front, cellar entrance center S side; beaded frames, ooloo trim, nosed sills; log joists in cellar. Entrance hall is a passage hall only, contains stair, but has no fireplace although room above does; no transom over W door because of stair above. Open stair arises from middle of E wall toward NE corner, has winders in corner, closed stringer, square banisters, square newell, class under corner. (photo 7)
Double faced woodwork; panelled jamb, chair rail; 6 panel doors, raised side; plaster partition wall 1st floor, beaded board walls upstairs. (photo 5)
Double faced shelf mantels w ooloo trim; press w pegged panelled doors 1st floor. Fireplace both rooms upstairs. Attic windows E end only. (photos 8, 9)

Log kitchen (perhaps older) on W. end of house w stone chimney, now connected by enclosed passage; shed porch on S side of kitchen (now enclosed). (photo 2)
Trunk Raised frame room added on SE corner of stone house (house re-oriented toward present road). Shed roof porch covers ^{present} front doorway - has chamfered posts turned upside down & brackets added. (photo 4)

(photo 10) House located above bank of Salt River; Spring N of house. Yard contains ruins of log dependency, an old snake house, and frame garage.

VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A at a fence post in the NW corner of the yard, then with fence, E 180 ft ^{to B}, S 150 ft ^{to C}, W 180 ft ^{to D} and N 150 ft ^{to beginning}, enclosing the stone house, log house, smoke house and log ruins - about 2/3 acre.
