4. Owner: Alfonso and Doris Garcia, 140 Delgado, Las Vegas, N.M.
7. Description: Sandstone foundation with concrete coping in places; light brown random ashlar sandstone walls (1st), stuccoed wood frame (2nd); wood shingle roof; moderate enclosed overhang with frieze boards; 6/1 double-hung windows, wood casement windows with segmental arches (1st) or board surrounds (2nd); porch railing, lumberyard classic columns. Located in a residential area of later construction two blocks northeast of the **Old Town Residential Historical District**.
8. Significance: Like the Angel House on South Pacific (ill. 18), the Shawn-Guerin House represents a local builder's novel adaptation of contemporary architectural features. Stone is used where brick was in the Colonial Revival and Bungalow Style houses on the other side of the river. The building's massing and wide eaves recall the Bungalow Style, while the classical columns of the porch and the symmetrical window/door/window beneath reflect turn of the century classicism.
