DESCRIPTION	<p>ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION AND PRESENT CONDITION: Georgian Revival, 1 story brick raised cottage, symmetrical plan and facade, center hall, low pitched hip roof with end wall chimneys. A pedimented dormer with palladio window is centered above entry. Front porch is flat roof with composite order columns and entablature. Center portico is extended with 2 columns supporting either side. Vertical wood balustrade between columns. Brick veneer construction on exposed brick foundation. Lot is generally flat with large boxwoods and azaleas along each side. House needs minor maintenance, generally good condition.</p>

Cargill ORIGINAL USE: Private dwelling ARCHITECT/BUILDER: HISTORIC ACREAGE: DATE OF CONSTRUCTION: ca. 1918 DATE(S) OF ALTERATIONS: HISTORICAL NARRATIVE (FROM ORIGINS TO PRESENT): Walter H. Cargill, and his wife, Mamie, built this house ca. 1918 and members of their family lived here until the early 1950's. Cargill was associated with "Hardaway-Cargill Co.," a locally based syrup manufacturing company.</p>

AREA(S) OF SIGNIFICANCE: Local History, Architecture LEVEL OF SIGNIFICANCE: Local STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL): <u>Local History</u>: This house, located in what was once Columbus' elite "High Uptown" neighborhood, is significant as it was the home of Walter H. Cargill, who was associated with "Hardaway-Cargill Co.," a locally based syrup manufacturing concern. <u>Architecture</u>: This house is located in what is known as "High Uptown" Columbus, it is a rare example of Georgian Revival style in Columbus.</p>
