



Pastor of the First African Baptist  
Church of Savannah

Whose soul made manifest glory  
was taken to Emmanuel's bosom  
on the 7<sup>th</sup> of Dec. A. D. 1856  
in Richmond Virginia on his way  
from the North where he had been  
labouring to procure aid to assist  
in erecting a new Church for his  
Congregation in Savannah Georgia  
and now lies in this silent tomb  
of his own creation here deposited  
in hope of a joyful resurrection to  
eternal life and glory.

He was a Man eminent in piety, of a  
humane benevolent and charitable  
disposition, his zeal in the cause of  
God was singular, his labours  
unforgettable, and his success in  
preaching the Gospel remarkable and  
astonishing, he departed this life  
in the One Hundredth Year of his  
age leaving a Wife and Family to  
lament his loss.

He Baptised 3726, Married 2000 &  
Funeralised 2400 Persons

Like him by many a other deed and price

Of which the world has seen Christ willon't*
