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Office Headquarters c. 1935

The Office Headquarters building was once used as an office and is now used as a private residence. This rectangular Rustic Resort style building has a continuous stone foundation and is of field-stone masonry construction. Wall material includes both field stone and weatherboard. The gable roof is covered with composition shingle. One exterior field-stone chimney is located on the eastern elevation; the other exterior field-stone chimney is located on the northwestern corner of the ell. On the northern elevation a stone patio is found, as well as a set of stone stairs leading up to the patio. A stone walkway crosses in front of the patio and stairs. A single-bay recess with a shed roof is located on the southern (front) facade. The windows are all double-hung with a two-over-two pane arrangement. Some of the windows and doors have been partially filled in with weatherboard.

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The land that would comprise Petit Jean State Park was donated to the State of Arkansas in the mid-1920's by individual landowners and sympathetic lumbering concerns as the first step in the formation of a state parks system. The top of Petit Jean Mountain had already been recognized for its scenic splendor, and for its geological wealth and diversity, and so seemed a particularly worthy site. The initial plan of these citizens was to turn the entire site over to the federal government for the establishment of a national park; however, after considerable study, National Park Service officials determined that Petit Jean Mountain was not a unique natural resource when evaluated on a national basis, and thus declined to assume ownership. Yet these same officials strongly encouraged the state to preserve and maintain the site as an important representation of Arkansas's natural heritage, and in 1923, the Arkansas Legislature passed Act 276 authorizing the Commissioner of State Lands to accept land donations for state parks and reservations. Thus began the Arkansas State Parks system, with Petit Jean State Park as its flagship.

The Office Headquarters was constructed c. 1935 at Petit Jean State Park by the men of the 1781st Company of the Civilian Conservation Corps, Arkansas District, stationed at Morrilton, Arkansas as an administrative building to be used by the park's staff for the management and administration of the park. This facility was constructed by the CCC as part of the overall plan to develop this part of the mountain as a public park to be administered by the state of Arkansas.

This building was erected at Petit Jean State Park by the men of the Civilian Conservation Corps for the purpose of providing office space for park staff, and was intended to be used for the management and maintenance of the park. Thus the Office Headquarters is eligible under Criterion A for its associations with both the Civilian Conservation Corps' importance within Arkansas social history and its role in the development of outdoor parks dedicated to public leisure and recreational activities. It is also eligible under Criterion C due to its status as a representative and intact example of the Rustic style of architecture that was made popular nationwide by the CCC, and which has since become virtually identified with it.

Beginning at a point on the western edge of State Highway 154 located approximately 300 feet south of Bench Mark 914, proceed westerly for a distance of 400 feet along a line running parallel with the building's northern elevation; thence proceed southerly along a line running parallel with the building's western elevation for a distance of 200 feet; thence proceed easterly along a line running parallel with the building's southern elevation for a distance of 400 feet to its intersection with the western edge of State Highway 154; thence proceed northerly along said edge for a distance of 200 feet to the point of beginning.

This boundary includes both the historic structure and a representative amount of the surrounding property historically-associated with this structure, including the principal approach to the building from State Highway 154.
